Oxygen Concentrator

Use per day varies, assume 12 to 24 hours a day. The 5-Liter model uses 400 W, the 3-Liter model uses 320 W.

Nebulizer

A medicine delivery system used mostly for pediatric care. Used 4-6 times a day for 20 minutes at a time at 75 W.

Semi/Fully Electric Hospital Beds

Use depends on adjustments. 200 W.

Alternating Pressure Pad

An air-filled mattress overlay. Used 24 hours a day for someone who is bed-ridden.

Low Air-Loss Mattress

Takes the place of mattress - air-filled pressurized mattress. Cycles air around every 15-20 minutes.

Power Wheelchairs and Scooters

Need to be charged approximately 8 hours every 3 days. Batteries are 120 V, 3 Amp, 360 W.

CPAP Machines

Used for Sleep Apnea. Machines run only at night for people who have a tendency to stop breathing at night. At maximum pressure they use 40 Watts. On average - 30Watts.
